



PRAYER WALKING ON YOUR MARK; GET READY; GET SET; GO!

The Lord has called His children to bring good news of salvation to the nations and to restore the desolate land. (Isaiah 49:6-10)

Believers in Christ spiritually can possess the land. (Joshua 1:1-11) Go on a prayer walk around your campus, city, neighborhood, work, or place of worship. A prayer walk is an outreach of faith, love, and action directed by the Lord anywhere at any time to His people. Joshua 1:3 states: "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses." Why should you go on a prayer walk?

- For nations of unbelievers to accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. (Psalm 2:8)
- For carnal believers to repent and return to the Lord. (Acts 3:19-21)
- To encourage believers in their faith and prayer life. (Ephesians 1:18-2:10)
- For restoration of the land defiled by man's sin. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

ON YOUR MARK

Check where you are to walk. What is the background information about the place and the people? What does the Lord want you to pray or to do there? Stand, wait, and listen until you hear the voice of the bridegroom and then go and do what He says and be filled with joy! (John 3:29) Take your position as a child of God having confessed and repented of all known sin and be the living sacrifice the Lord can use. (Romans 12:1-2)

GET READY

What things should you prepare for a prayer walk?

- Paper and pen to write names, addresses, phone numbers, and prayer requests
- Tracts, a small Bible or Scriptures on paper, and your testimony
- What you will pray, proclaim, declare, praise, plant, or build
- Map of where you will be praying, with historical or spiritually significant sites specifically marked
- Information and directions with information about a place to worship

GET SET

- Put on the whole armor of God. (Ephesians 6:10-20, Romans 13:12)
- Be ready to walk in the wisdom and power of the Spirit. (Ephesians 5:1, 15)

GO!

- Praise the Lord. (Psalm 100 and Psalm 22:3)
- Proclaim the knowledge of God and the glory of the Lord over this area of the earth. (Psalm 24:1, 1 Peter 2:4-10)
- Separate this land and people to the Lord and ask Him to cleanse and purify them. (Genesis 13:14-18, Ezekiel 40-43, Ezekiel 47)
- Share with the people about Christ Jesus so they may know Him as Savior and Lord. (Romans 10)
- Give the people time to repent, receive the Lord, and consecrate themselves to Him. (Joshua 3:5)
- Bless the people and the land to be holy and to know the Lord's presence. (Psalm 103)
- Pray for one another (James 5:16) and in Jesus' name. (John 14:14)
- Ask the Lord to spiritually exchange darkness for the light. (Matthew 12:29-30, 43-45)

AT THE FINISH LINE

Give God glory! Declare what He has done! Seek Him for how you are to minister to those you have just met and the next place where you are to prayer walk. (Psalm 105:1-5)
