



PRAYER WALKING ON YOUR MARK; GET READY; GET SET; GO!

The Lord has called His children to bring good news of salvation to the nations and to restore the desolate land. (Isaiah 49:6-10)

Believers in Christ spiritually can possess the land. (Joshua 1:1-11) Go on a prayer walk around a campus, city, neighborhood, work, or place of worship. A prayer walk is an outreach of faith, love, and action directed by the Lord anywhere at any time to His people. Joshua 1:3 The Lord says to Joshua: ***“Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses.”***

Why should you go on a prayer walk?

- For nations to accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. (Psalm 2:8)
- For immature believers to repent and return to the Lord. (Acts 3:19-21)
- To encourage believers in their faith and prayer life. (Ephesians 1:18-2:10)
- For restoration of the land defiled by man’s sin. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

ON YOUR MARK

Check information about the people and place where you are to walk. What does the Lord want you to pray or do there? Stand, wait, and listen until you hear the voice of the bridegroom and then go and do what He says and be filled with joy! (John 3:29) Take your position as a child of God having confessed and received God’s forgiveness for all known sin. Be the living sacrifice transformed by God and a vessel available for His use. (Romans 12:1-2)

GET READY

What things might you need for a prayer walk?

- Paper and pen to write names, addresses, phone numbers, and prayer requests
- Tracts, a small Bible or Scriptures on paper, and your testimony
- Words God gives you to pray, proclaim, declare, and praise
- Map where you will be praying with historical or spiritually significant sites specifically marked
- Information and directions to the local church or ministry

GET SET

- Put on the whole armor of God. (Ephesians 6:10-20, Romans 13:12)
- Be a man or woman of peace (Psalm 37:37, Luke 10). Look for others of peace to help you.
- Consecrate yourself to the Lord and be ready to see His wonders! (Joshua 3:5)
- Walk in the wisdom and power of the Spirit. (Ephesians 5:1, 15)

GO!

- Praise the Lord. (Psalm 100 and Psalm 22:3)
- **Proclaim:** *“The Lord reigns, Let the earth rejoice....”, “The earth is the Lord’s”, “The earth shall be full of the knowledge of Lord as the waters cover the sea.”* (Psalm 97:1, 24:1, Isaiah 11:9b)
- Cast off the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. (Romans 13:12-14)
- Separate the land and people to the Lord and ask Him to cleanse and purify them. (Genesis 13:14-18, Ezekiel 40-43, Ezekiel 47)
- Share with the people about Jesus Christ Who is Savior and Lord. Give them time to repent and receive Him. (Romans 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9-10, and John 1:12)
- Bless the people and the land to be holy and to know the Lord’s presence. (Psalm 103)
- Pray for one another (James 5:16) in Jesus’ name. (John 14:14)
- Ask the Lord to spiritually exchange darkness for His light. (Matthew 12:29-30, 43-45)

AT THE FINISH LINE

Give God glory! Declare what He has done! Seek Him for how you are to minister to those you have just met and the next place where you can prayer walk. (Psalm 105:1-5)
